## Why do we have this schedule?

This schedule allows us to have one teacher for two groups and we can use one classroom for two groups on a day. This way, we can offer our programmes at the most attractive rates.

Our main focus is clients who book accommodation, because that's the added value of our language campus. The advantage for this type of schedule... there are enough day parts available for site seeing (typically in the afternoon) and at the same time it allows people to have a few evenings for going out and having a late night.

Please note that our program is intensive. At least 3-4 hours per day should be spent on homework/self study. Most people who request the schedule, want to know how they can fit the schedule with their job and other activities. However, we strongly recommend NOT to book this course if you work at the same time or have other activities that consume a significant part of your day/your energy. This is a course where every participant has one priority: learning Dutch and it's very intensive.

'Weekend+week+weekend' schedule - compared to the past: we decided to add 5 minutes per day in the first 8 days. And have a shorter last day. This decision was made, based on the feedback from our students: many people prefer to leave on Sunday as they work on Monday. People prefer to drive back during daylight and home not very late.
