Why do we have this schedule?

This schedule allows us to have one teacher for two groups and we can use one classroom for two groups on a day. This way, we can offer our programs at the most attractive rate.

Our main focus is clients who book accommodation and travel from elsewhere. The advantage for this type of schedule... there are enough day parts available for site seeing (typically in the afternoon) and at the same time it allows people to have a few evenings for going out and having a late night.

Please note that our program is intensive. At least 3-4 hours per day should be spent on homework/self study. Most people who request the schedule, want to know how they can fit the schedule with their job and other activities. However, we strongly recommend NOT to book this course in combination if you work at the same time or have other activities that consume a part of your day. This really is a course where every participant has one priority: learning Dutch.
